Honorable chairman, Members of management committee, parents & dear staff members. My heartfelt greetings & cordial welcome to this extravaganza of Annual Day celebration of AFS Manauri. It's with great pleasure I present in a nut shell the highlights of the academic year 2023-24.

The school saw its opening for the academic year 2023-24 on 01 Apr 2023. Our school office bearers were officially sworn in a very impressive investiture ceremony.

Academic excellence :

The system of education in AFS is a blend of theory and practice in right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum with academics being priority. Under the guidance of 25 trained and effective teaching staff over 530 students are receiving life and job oriented knowledge regularly.

This year 76 students of our school are going to appear for the board examination, like previous year where our X result was 100% and XII 92% we hope to attain 100% board results this year in both the categories.

Our classrooms are well equipped with latest technology that includes LED smart boards and Internet facilities. It is mandatory for our teachers to utilize digital methodology of teaching. Various competitions & activities are conducted at class room & at inter house level.

Special attention is given to our board appearing students, other than the daily classes, our students are prepared well through continuous extra classes during zero period, Autumn and Winter breaks, open book assessment and remedial classes for weak students are taken before board examination.

SPORTS

'All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy. Bearing this in mind, the school provides ample opportunities to students to perform regular exercise. Many students have participated in various sports events like Athletics, badminton, TT etc and have won laurels for school.

Ariba Asmar Husain & Sneha Singh won silver medal in TT in AF School sports & athletics championship at command level. 18 of our students were selected for inter zonal selection trial held at AF School Chakeri. Our BB team also participated in CBSE regional level competition held at Prayagraj. We successfully organized our Annual Sports Day on 22 Nov 23.

CO-CURRICULAR

By providing a conducive and encouraging environment, the students are mentored to participate in variety of intra and inter class co curricular activities from kindergarten to Sr Sec. level on monthly basis.



Apart from all these school also conducted various activities such as International year of Millets, Cyber Security and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan as per the directive of the command.

Students & teachers are given lectures and training to operate during the time of emergency such as Fire break, Earth quake, Road Safety, Terrorist attack etc., mock drills of the same are often conducted in the school.

TEACHERS ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME:

Time and again we send and organize various workshops and in-service-training for our teachers to upgrade them with latest teaching methodology and technological aids. To mention some of the workshop our teachers attended this year are:

- School quality Assessment and assurance workshop.
- Training on use of audio, video & smart board for effective teaching.

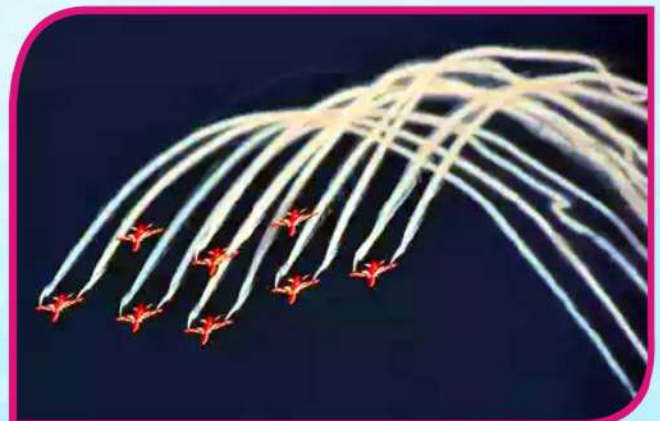

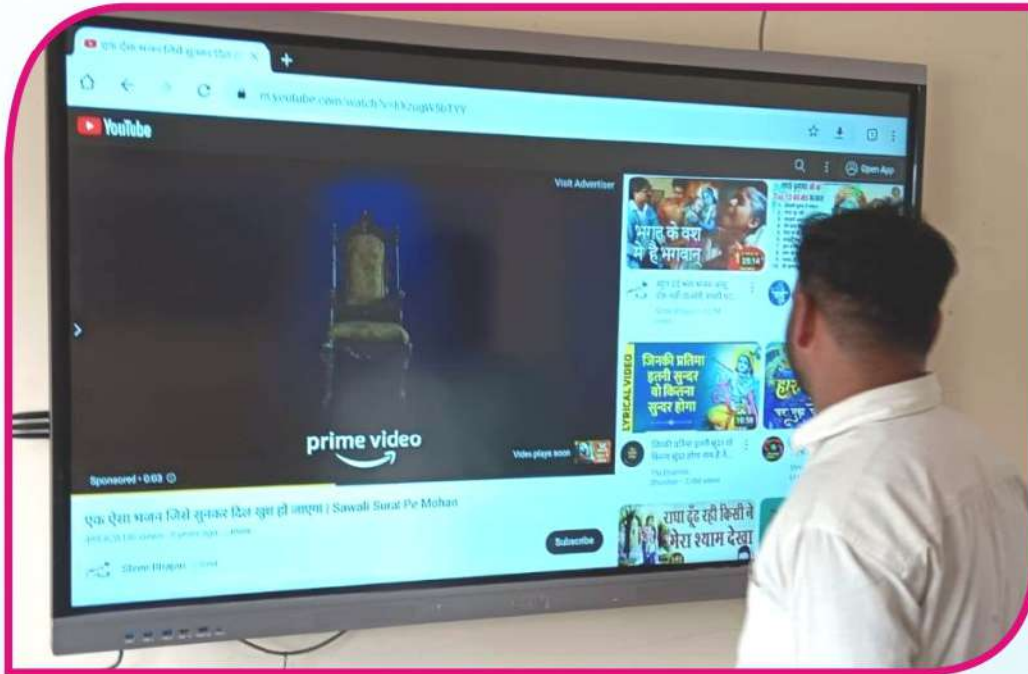
Dear teachers your dedication, passion and unwavering commitment to education have felt indelible mark on our hearts.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND THE FUTURE OF HUMANS

Hear the term artificial intelligence (AI) and you might think of self-driving cars, robots, ChatGPT or other AI chatbots, and artificially created images. But it's also important to look behind the outputs of AI and understand how the technology works and its impacts for this and future generations.



AI is a concept that has been around, formally, since the 1950s, when it was defined as a machine's ability to perform a task that would've previously required human intelligence. This is quite a broad definition and one that has been modified over decades of research and technological advancements.

When you consider assigning intelligence to a machine, such as a computer, it makes sense to start by defining the term 'intelligence' -- especially when you want to determine if an artificial system is truly deserving of it.

The rise of artificial intelligence will make most people better off over the next decade, but many have concerns about how advances in AI will affect what it means to be human, to be productive and to exercise free

Digital life is augmenting human capacities and disrupting eons-old human activities. Code-driven systems have spread to more than half of the world's inhabitants in ambient information and connectivity, offering previously unimagined opportunities and unprecedented threats. As emerging algorithm-driven artificial intelligence (AI) continues to spread, will people be better off than they are today?

The experts predicted networked artificial intelligence will amplify human effectiveness but also threaten human autonomy, agency and capabilities. They spoke of the wide-ranging possibilities; that computers might match or even exceed human intelligence and capabilities on tasks such as complex decision-making, reasoning and learning, sophisticated analytics and pattern recognition, visual acuity, speech recognition and language translation. They said "smart" systems in communities, in vehicles, in buildings and utilities, on farms and in business processes will save time, money and lives and offer opportunities for individuals to enjoy a more-customized future.



Many focused their optimistic remarks on health care and the many possible applications of AI in diagnosing and treating patients or helping senior citizens live fuller and healthier lives. They were also enthusiastic about AI's role in contributing to broad public-health programs built around massive amounts of data that may be captured in the coming years about everything from personal genomes to nutrition. Additionally, a number of these experts predicted that AI would abet long-anticipated changes in formal and informal education systems.



What are some recent examples of AI?

Overall, the most notable advancements in AI are the development and release of GPT 3.5 and GPT 4. But there have been many other revolutionary achievements in artificial intelligence -- too many, in fact, to include all of them here. Here are some of the most notable:



ChatGPT (and the GPTs)

ChatGPT is an AI chatbot capable of natural language generation, translation, and answering questions. Though it's arguably the most popular AI tool, thanks to its widespread accessibility, OpenAI made significant waves in the world of artificial intelligence with the creation of GPTs 1, 2, and 3. GPT stands for Generative Pre-trained Transformer, and GPT-3 was the largest language model in existence at the time of its 2020 launch, with 175 billion parameters. The latest version, GPT-4, accessible through ChatGPT Plus or Bing Chat, has one trillion parameters. Self-driving cars Though the safety of self-driving cars is a top concern of potential users, the technology continues to advance and improve with breakthroughs in AI. These vehicles use machine-learning algorithms to combine data from sensors and cameras to perceive their surroundings and determine the best course of action. Robotics The achievements of Boston Dynamics stand out in the area of AI and robotics. Though we're still a long way away from creating AI at the level of technology seen in the movie Terminator, watching Boston Dynamics' robots use AI to navigate and respond to different terrains is impressive.
